<p>COVID-19 Update (MoH) Please refer to MoH presentation from here</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • West Bank is in 5th wave whilst Gaza in 4th wave. • Number of cases expected to continue to rise for the coming days. • Encouraging people to get vaccinated as well as get booster shots. <p>2021 Cluster Coordination Performance Monitoring Results + Health Cluster HRP 2022 and priorities Please refer to Health Cluster presentation from here</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There will be a workshop to review the results of the CCPM in more details however, there was low response rate from partners an issue that needs to be addressed in 2022. <p>Working Groups Update</p> <p>Mobile Clinics</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Major concern regarding funding for mobile clinics as many ceased service provision at the end of December and others will run out of funding end of March. • In 2021 there were 175 locations targeted however this has dropped to 80, which leaves many vulnerable communities in Area C without access to basic services. • With the reduced service provision, there has been increased burden on the remaining service providers. <p>Advocacy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Planning to have a meeting with members as follow up from the workshop conducted end of last year around access. • Inviting any partners who are interested to join the Advocacy group <p>Trauma</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Working on initiating MCM training across West Bank but this has been postponed due to increased COVID-19 cases

- UNFPA reported that they are working with the MoH on the SRH Emergency Plan
