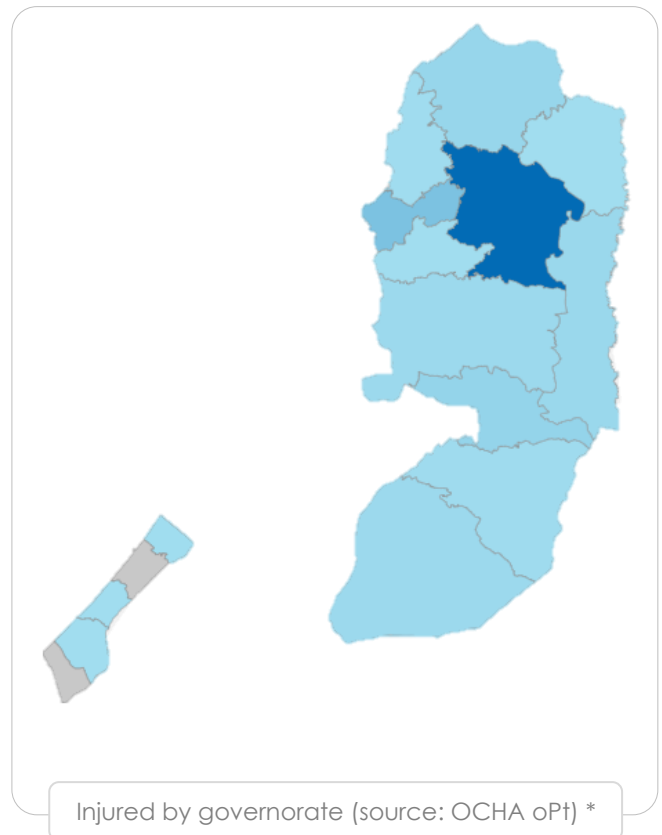
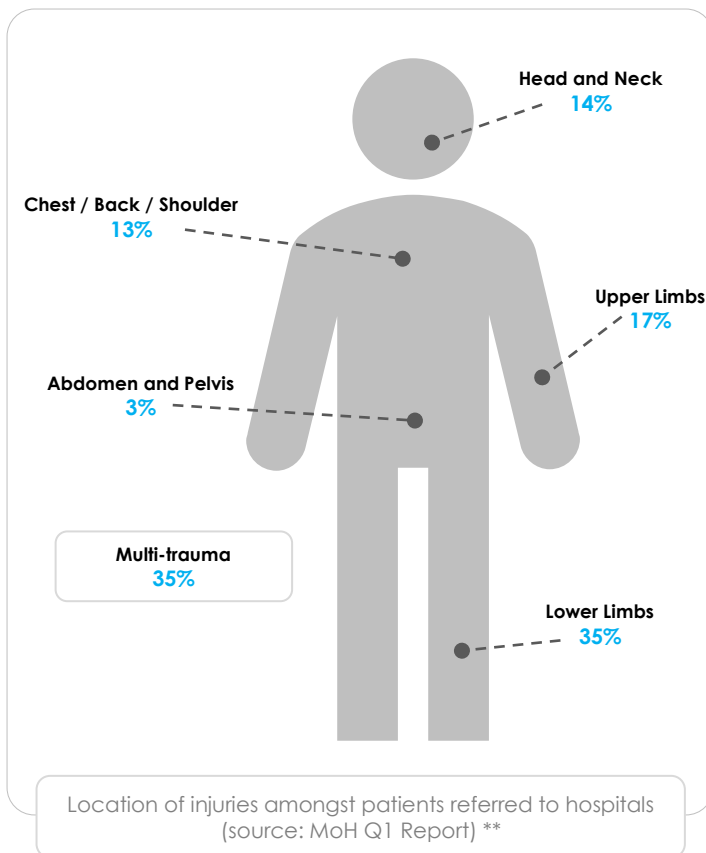

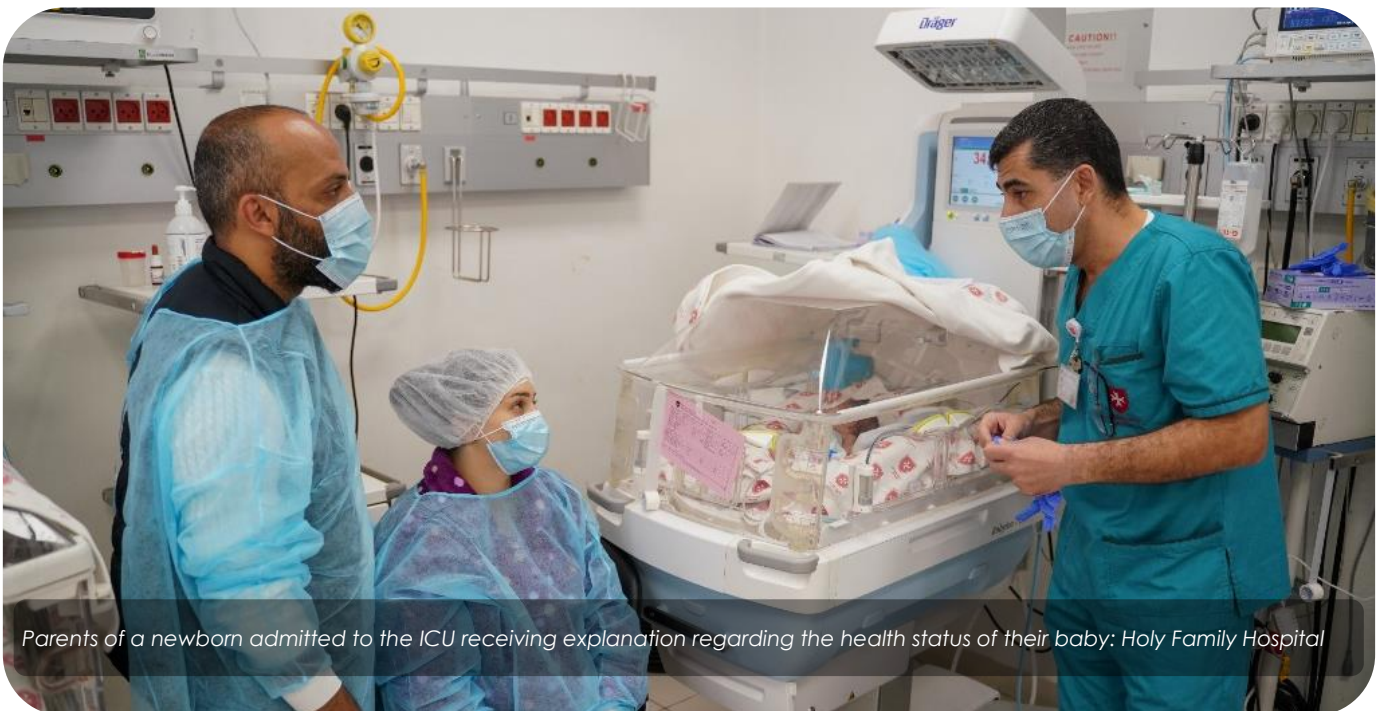

Health access and attacks on healthcare



In the first quarter of 2023, there were 78 attacks on health care in the oPt, recorded and verified across oPt in [WHO's Surveillance System for Attacks on Health Care \(SSA\)](#).

There were **75 health attacks in the West Bank including East Jerusalem**.

- 3 in East Jerusalem
- 72 in the West Bank outside East Jerusalem

As a result of attacks, there were 70 ambulances and other vehicles affected (62 obstructed, 10 damaged, 4 targeted not damaged, 4 searched, 3 used as shield, 1 detained); at least 66 health workers affected (24 injured, 12 targeted not injured, 19 obstructed, 3 searched, 7 verbally abused or intimidated, 4 arrested or detained); and 3 health care facilities affected.

There were **3 health attacks in the Gaza Strip**:

As a result of these attacks, there were 2 health workers affected (physically and verbally attacked) and 1 health facility affected, while 1 patient and 1 patient companion were arrested while traveling to access health care.
